^{5/} Out-of-state MBA in Design Strategy students who travel monthly to CCA can receive an augmentation to their travel allowance that will allow them to borrow additional student loan. To request this allowance, please file a Statement of Student Expenses form found on the CCA Financial Aid Web site. The augmentation is a set amount of either \$6,200 or \$7,900, depending on the student's state of residence.

^{6/} Visual and Critical Studies dual-degree students can anticipate tuition charges for 30 units per year for the first two years of the program and tuition charges for 18 units for the third year of the dual-degree program. Tuition charges for year one of the dual-degree program in 2011-12 are \$38,550.
