	NOTE: Although the transfer equivalents specified above will satisfy the 3-semester-unit CCA requirement for CORES-100: Drawing 1, one (1) additional semester unit will be added to students' Studio Elective requirement to compensate for the unit deficiency herein.
CORES-104: 2-D	ARTS-8: Design (2 semester units)
	NOTE: Although the transfer equivalent specified above will satisfy the 3-semester-unit CCA requirement for CORES-104: 2-D, one (1) additional semester unit will be added to students' Studio Elective requirement to compensate for the unit deficiency herein.
CORES-108: 3-D	ARTS-10A: 3-Dimensional Design (2 semester units)

	Or, BOTH courses (4.7 semester units) from the following selection:
	F/TV-10: Introduction to Electronic Media (2.7 semester units) ARTS-85: Motion Graphics (semester units)
	NOTE: Whereas the transfer equivalents specified in each case for CCA's 3-unit CORES-112: 4-D requirement will satisfy that requirement, 1.7 semester units from each combination may be used as Studio Elective units for all CCA majors.
