Non-Release of (Public/Directory) Information

California College of the Arts has designated some information about you as directory information available to the public. This information includes: name, email address, dates of attendance, enrollment status, major, academic awards and honors, and degrees received. This means the College can release this information to anyone who requests it. You have the opportunity to suppress this information from public release.

Suppression might have undesirable consequences. Some of the effects of your decision to request confidential status will be that friends or relatives trying to reach you will not be able to do so through the College; information that you are a student here will be suppressed, so that if a loan company, prospective employer, professional acquaintance, etc., inquire about you, they will be informed that we have no record of your attendance.

Once you have designated a confidential classification, it will not be removed until you submit a signed authorization requesting such action.
